

Trash Service Guidelines

- Trash pickup is every Wednesday and Saturday. If the regularly scheduled pickup day falls on New Years Day or Christmas Day the pickup will resume the following scheduled collection day.
- Recycling is not included in the neighborhood contract, but is available to residents directly through Texas Pride.
- Household garbage will be collected curbside. When possible, place garbage containers at the curbside, adjacent to the driveway.
- Residential refuse must be either in personal containers not to exceed ninety-six (96) gallons or bags not exceeding fifty (50) pounds. Tree branches should be tied and bundled measuring no more than four (4) feet in length, six (6) inches in diameter, and weigh no more than fifty (50) pounds. This excludes any waste generated as a result of a force majeure event.
- Excluded Items: As part of normal collection, Texas Pride Disposal does not pick up dirt, rocks, bricks, concrete, tires, items containing Freon, fuels, oils, batteries, fertilizer, chemicals, liquid paint, or any materials or items deemed hazardous materials or waste generated by a private contractor.
- Bulky Waste: Bulky waste includes furniture, appliances, and other larger items not placed out for collection on a regular basis. Refrigerators and freezers must be drained of Freon and have a bill to validate such service was performed. Two bulky waste items will be collected from each home on every service day.
- Yard Waste: Yard waste includes grass clippings, leaves, plants, and tree trimmings. Up to eight (8) bags/bundles will be collected from each home every service day.
- Excess Volume: For special collection other than normal amounts of residential refuse, yard trimmings, or bulk items (a "Special Collection"), residents can go to www.texaspridedisposal.com/cleanup and upload photos of excess volume needing to be disposed of. A price will be provided, and once payment has been made by resident, collection will be provided curbside on next scheduled collection day or agreed-upon date.
- Spillage: Texas Pride Disposal shall clean up any spillage that occurs during the collection process; provided, however, that if gasoline, motor oil, cooking oil, paint, or any other liquid items in a garbage container are not seen by Texas Pride Disposal personnel resulting in spillage that causes a stain, Texas Pride Disposal shall not be responsible.
- Container: Residents will use their own cans or bags. Cans should be built for the intended use of garbage collection and be between twenty (20) and ninety-six (96) gallons in size. Cans and bags should not exceed fifty (50) pounds.
