* The General Liability Waiver must be completed to activate your card for 2023 pool season. Pool cards must be utilized for access- Life guards will NOT open the gate- If your card is not active, contact <u>rpwcoordinator@gmail.com</u> or 346-380-9743 for assistance during business hours.

- 1) Riverpark West pool is for the exclusive use of Riverpark West residents who are dues paying members in good standing with the HOA.
- 2) Please limit non-swimming adults to 2 (two) per household.
- Children under 16 years old or less than four feet tall must be accompanied by a parent or responsible person.
 While in the water, the parent/responsible person must remain within arm's reach at all times.
- 4) All children under the age of 4 years old must wear a swimsuit diaper or plastic pants and a swim suit regardless of toilet training.
- 5) All pool users must wear appropriate swimsuit attire. Generally, all pool users must be wearing swimsuits and attire that are specified for pool use.
- 6) Animals are not allowed in the pool area, with the exception of guide/service dogs. Guide/service dogs are allowed on deck, but not in the water.
- 7) Person under the influence of alcohol or narcotics will be denied admission and/or asked to leave the premises.
- 8) Candy, food or beverages are not allowed except in designated areas provided for eating or drinking, but not within 8 feet of the pool. No glass items, chewing gum or smoking is permitted.
- 9) Suntan oils may not be used by swimmers.
- 10) All residents must shower before entering the pool. Persons with open cuts, sores, bandages, colds, coughs or infected eyes are not permitted in the pool.
- 11) Spitting, spouting or nose- blowing in the pool is strictly prohibited.
- 12) Lying on the deck close to the edge of the pool where swimmers may trip over sunbathers is dangerous. Sunbathers must lie or sit at least three (3) feet away from the edge of the pool or in a designated area for such activity.
- 13) Diving or flips are not permitted at any time. Any resident wishing to jump from into the pool, must jump feet first and jump straight ahead away from the pool wall.
- 14) Swimmers must leave the pool area immediately upon the signal or request of the lifeguards and/or other pool employees to ensure the safety of everyone.
- 15) Foul or abusive language will not be tolerated.
- 16) Please plan on bringing your own folding chairs
- 17) No pool parties or other social events
- 18) Use of the mushroom is TBD by Lifeguard staff
- 19) No game playing that interferes with social distancing
- 20) Restroom use limited to one family at a time
- 21) Limited guests will be allowed through the 2023 pool season
- 22) No lost and found will be kept
- 23) Please refer to the posted good practice references for COVID-19

Walk at all times!!! No running.
