## **POOL RULES**

### **ENTRY REGULATIONS**

- RESIDENTS 18 YEARS AND OLDER ALLOWED TWO NON-RESIDENT GUESTS ONLY
- RESIDENTS 17 YEARS AND YOUNGER ALLOWED ONE NON-RESIDENT GUEST ONLY
- NO ENTRY TO THE POOL IS PERMITTED AFTER HOURS. VIOLATORS WILL BE SUBJECT TO TRESPASS LAWS.
- PRIVATE PARTIES BY PERMIT ONLY
- MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ACTION OF THEIR GUESTS
- ALL CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 12 YEARS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT 18 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER

#### **POOL REGULATIONS**

- ALL NON-SWIMMERS MUST BE WITHIN PARENT/GUARDIANS ARMS REACH AT ALL TIMES. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- PROPER SWIMMING ATTIRE REQUIRED (NO CUTOFF SHORTS OR STREET CLOTHES)
- INDIVIDUALS WITH INFECTIONS OR BANDAGES ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE POOL
- ONLY SMALL FLOATING ITEMS ARE ALLOWED IN THE POOL AND SUBJECT TO POOL MANAGER'S DISCRETION
- BABIES IN DIAPERS NOT ALLOWED IN POOL. SWIM DIAPERS ALLOWED
- NO FOOD, DRINKS OR GUM ALLOWED IN POOL
- NO PUSHING OR THROWING OF PEOPLE IN THE POOL
- COCOA BUTTER, BABY OIL AND OTHER HEAVY OILS AND LOTIONS ARE NOT PERMITTED DUE TO POTENTIAL EQUIPMENT DAMAGE
- NO DIVING EXCEPT IN AREAS WHERE DIVING IS PERMITTED

#### **DECK REGULATIONS**

- THE POOL GATE MUST BE CLOSED AT ALL TIMES
- NO GLASS CONTAINERS OR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED WITHIN FENCED POOL AREA
- NO SMOKING AT ANY TIME
- NO BICYCLES, SKATEBOARDS, ROLLER SKATES, OR IN-LINE SKATES IN POOL AREA
- NO RUNNING OR EXCESSIVE HORESPLAY
- NO PETS ARE PERMITTED ON POOL PREMISES
- NO EXCESSIVE NOISE OR MUSIC
- NO PLUG IN ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES ARE ALLOWED IN POOL AREA

## THERE WILL BE A TEN MINUTE ADULT SWIM PERIOD EVERY HOUR

LIFEGUARDS ARE EMPLOYED FOR THE SAFETY OF THE MEMBERS AND THEIR GUESTS. THEY HAVE FULL AUTHORITY TO ENFORCE ANY AND ALL POOL RULES AND TO SUSPEND VIOLATORS' PRIVILEGES.

POOL MANAGEMENT NOR CREST MANAGEMENT HOA ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ITEMS DAMAGED, STOLEN OR LOST IN THE POOL FACILITY.

### **EXHIBIT "B"**

# GENERAL POOL RULES FOR STANDARD SUBDIVISION POOLS

Rules may vary from pool to pool depending on design of pool and individual BOD requests.

All pools should have specific rules posted at the pool.

- 1. No running or rough play.
- 2. No glass containers or alcoholic beverages allowed in pool area.
- 3. No diving in shallow end of pool (less than 6 feet).
- Only small floating items, upon pool manager's discretion, will be allowed in the pool.
- 5. Only one person allowed on diving board at one time.
- 6. All swimmers must dive straight out and not off to the side of the diving boards, then quickly get out of the deep end.
- 7. No pets are permitted on the pool premises.
- Proper swimming attire required.
- Lifeguards are responsible for all swimmers in all pools; however, all nonswimming children must be primarily supervised by a parent or guardian within arm's reach.
- 10. The use of cocoa butter, baby oil, and other heavy suntan oils causes filter damage. It is advised that these lotions not be permitted in the pool.
- Members who have guests must sign them in and be responsible for them at all times. It is advised that no more than three (3) guests be allowed per member.
- 12. A ten (10) minute "Safety Break" will be called for ten minutes every hour, by the lifeguard. During this period, all swimmers must exit all bodies of water.
- No swimming after designated swimming hours, unless special arrangements have been made through the management company of the Board of Directors.
- Voluntary breath holding exercises or contests is strictly prohibited.
- 15. No loud music around the pool area.
- 16. Lifeguard has the final authority on interpretation of rules.
- 17. Lifeguard's primary responsibility is to ensure safety and perform direct supervision of patrons in the pool. This responsibility precedes over general maintenance duties.
